Tozour Energy Systems' headquarters in King of Prussia, PA., received a score of 85 percent, proving that the company is on the front line of driving energy savings.

In the last year, ENERGY STAR partners have reduced greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to those from 33 million cars. Additionally, these initiatives have delivered \$18 billion last year in energy and cost savings to businesses, organizations and consumers across the country.
